Essential Question:

How can we decide if information is safe, fair, and responsible to share?



Privacy

Protect personal and others' information.



Accuracy

Check facts and share only what is true.



Property

Respect copyright and give credit when needed.



Access

Share with the right people in the right places.



Digital Footprint

Think about the long-term impact of what you share online.

One post can create many problems



1. Did they give permission?

Always respect others' choices and boundaries.

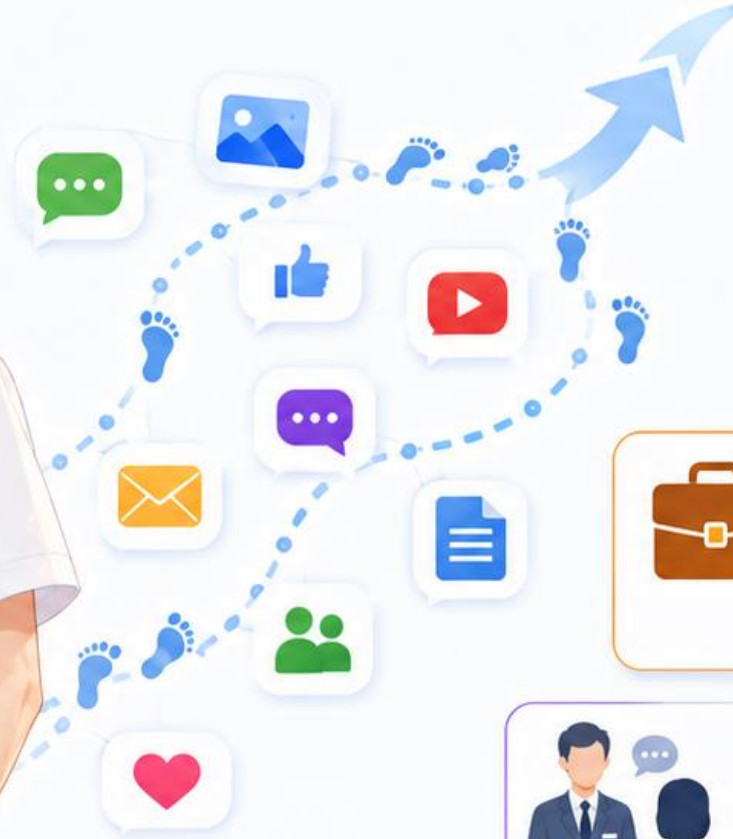
Why Should We Be Careful?

Online sharing can affect your future

What you share can affect:

- your privacy
- your reputation
- your friendships
- your school life
- your university applications
- your future career

You share something online



University Admissions

Universities may review your online presence.



Scholarships

Opportunities can be influenced by your digital image.



Job Opportunities

Employers often check candidates online.



Interviews & Future Career

Your online actions can shape how others see you.



Your online actions become part of your **digital identity**.



The PAPA Model

Four questions before sharing



P – Privacy

A – Accuracy

P: Privacy

Protect personal information

Before sharing, ask:



Is this my personal information?



Is this someone else's information?



Did they give permission?



Could this information cause harm?



Do not share

phone number



ID card



passwords



private messages



medical or financial information



Ask for permission before sharing someone else's information.



A: Accuracy

Check before you share

Accuracy means checking if information is **true** before sharing it.

Official source • Clear date • Reliable



Before sharing, ask:



Is this true?



Where did it come from?



Is the source reliable?



Is it up to date?



Do other sources confirm it?



Source

Check where it comes from.



Date

Check when it was published.



Confirm

Check with other reliable sources.



Do not share information only because it looks interesting.

P: Property

Respect ownership and copyright

เคารพลิขสิทธิ์และเจ้าของผลงาน

Original creator

? Before using content, ask:

- Who created this?
- Do I have permission?
- Do I need to give credit?
- Is it copyrighted?
- Can I use it for school work?



They own the content they create.

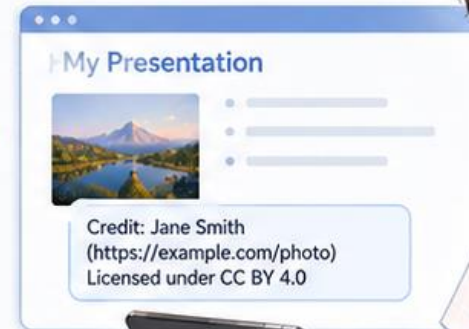
Respect ownership before you use.



Give credit

Ask permission when needed

Responsible use



Use content responsibly and give proper credit.

Examples of owned content:



photos



music



videos



articles



designs



presentations



Give **credit** and ask **permission** when needed.



Respect creators.
Build a better digital community.

A: Access

Control who can see it

ควบคุมการเข้าถึงข้อมูล

? Before sharing, ask:

- Who should see this?
- Is it public or private?
- Should only classmates see it?
- Should teachers or parents see it?
- Can others download or copy it?

Examples:

- public post
- private message
- class group
- shared folder
- portfolio link



Remember: Access means deciding who can see or use your information.



Think first. Share smart. Stay safe.



Digital Footprint

Everything you share can leave a trace

Your digital footprint can include:

- Posts
- Comments
- Photos
- Videos
- Likes
- Shares
- Username
- Public Profiles

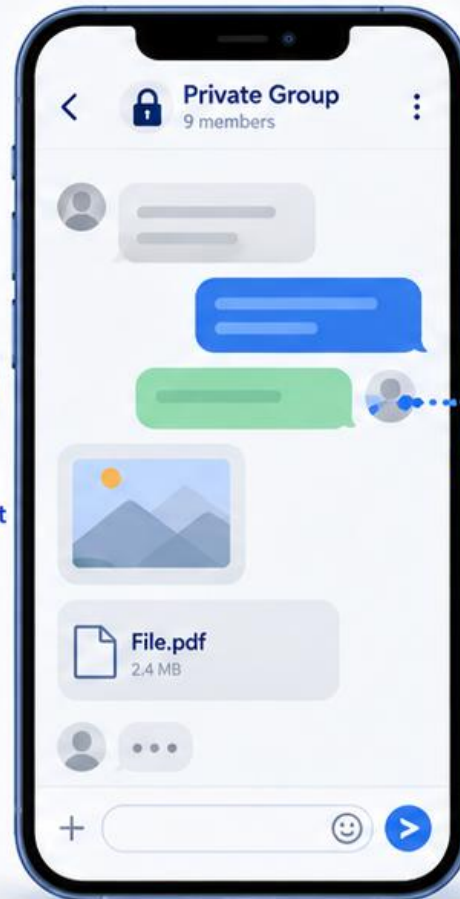


There Are No Secrets Online

Private does not always mean safe

Even in a private group:

-  people can screenshot
-  people can forward messages
-  files can be downloaded
-  photos can be reposted
-  messages can be taken out of context

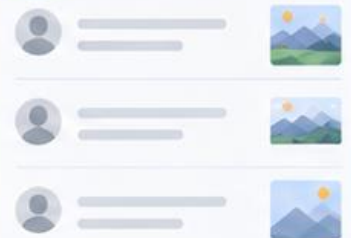

Protect yourself and others

What you share today can stay online forever.



Small Details Can Be Used to Deceive You

Be careful with information that seems harmless

 **Phishing** = การหลอกลวงทางออนไลน์

Even simple details can be risky:

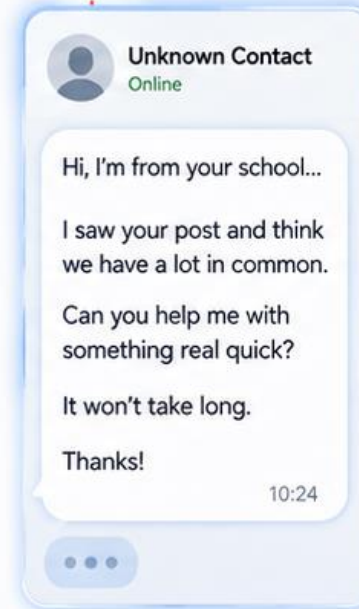
 1. Full Name Example: Nattapong S.	 2. Birthday Example: 15 Aug 2008	 3. School Name Example: Yorworor School	 4. Hobbies Example: Basketball
 5. Friend Names Example: Aun, Beam, Game	 6. Class Schedule Example: Math (Mon 1st)	 7. Job Title Example: Part-time Tutor	 8. Location Example: Bangkok



Scammers can use details to make fake messages look real.



Example of a suspicious message



- Unknown sender
- Requests personal help
- Tries to build trust
- May lead to scams



Small details may seem harmless, but together they can reveal who you are.

Legal and Ethical Responsibility



Respect personal data and copyright



Be careful before posting:



copyrighted music



movies or video clips



other people's photos



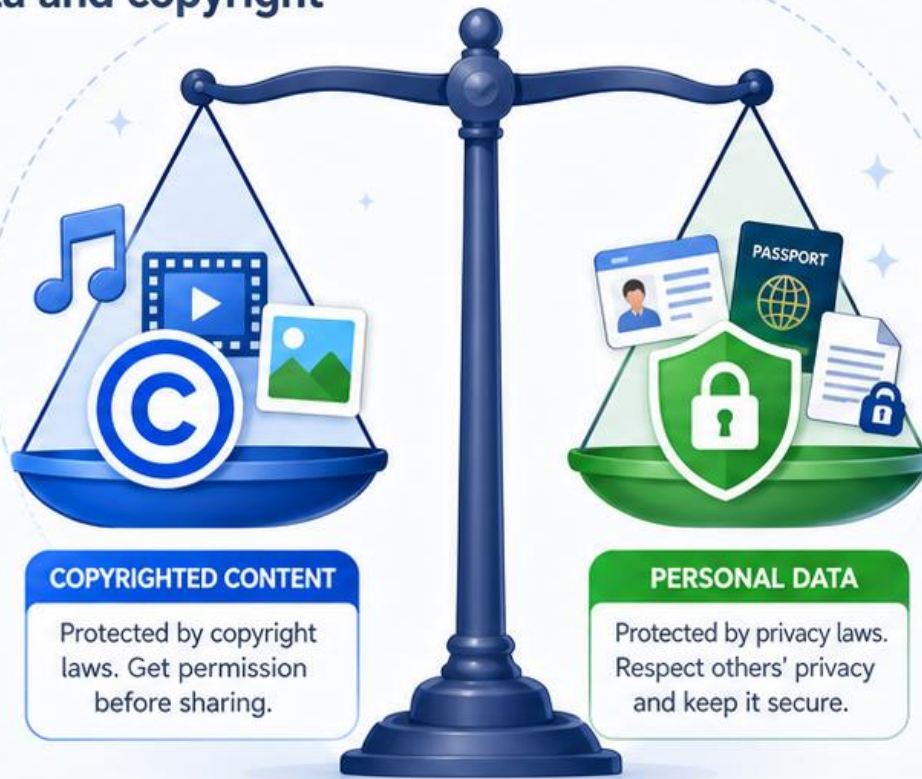
ID cards or passports



private documents



someone else's personal information



COPYRIGHTED CONTENT

Protected by copyright laws. Get permission before sharing.

PERSONAL DATA

Protected by privacy laws. Respect others' privacy and keep it secure.

PERMISSION CHECKLIST

- ☒ Do I own the rights to this content?
- ☒ Do I have permission to share it?
- ☒ Does it include anyone's personal information?
- ☒ Will sharing this respect others?

If any answer is NO, don't post it.



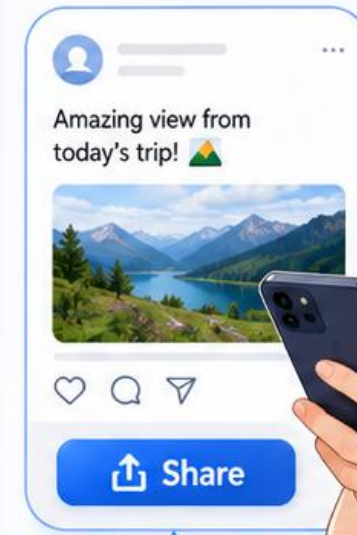
Responsible sharing means **respecting rights.**
