

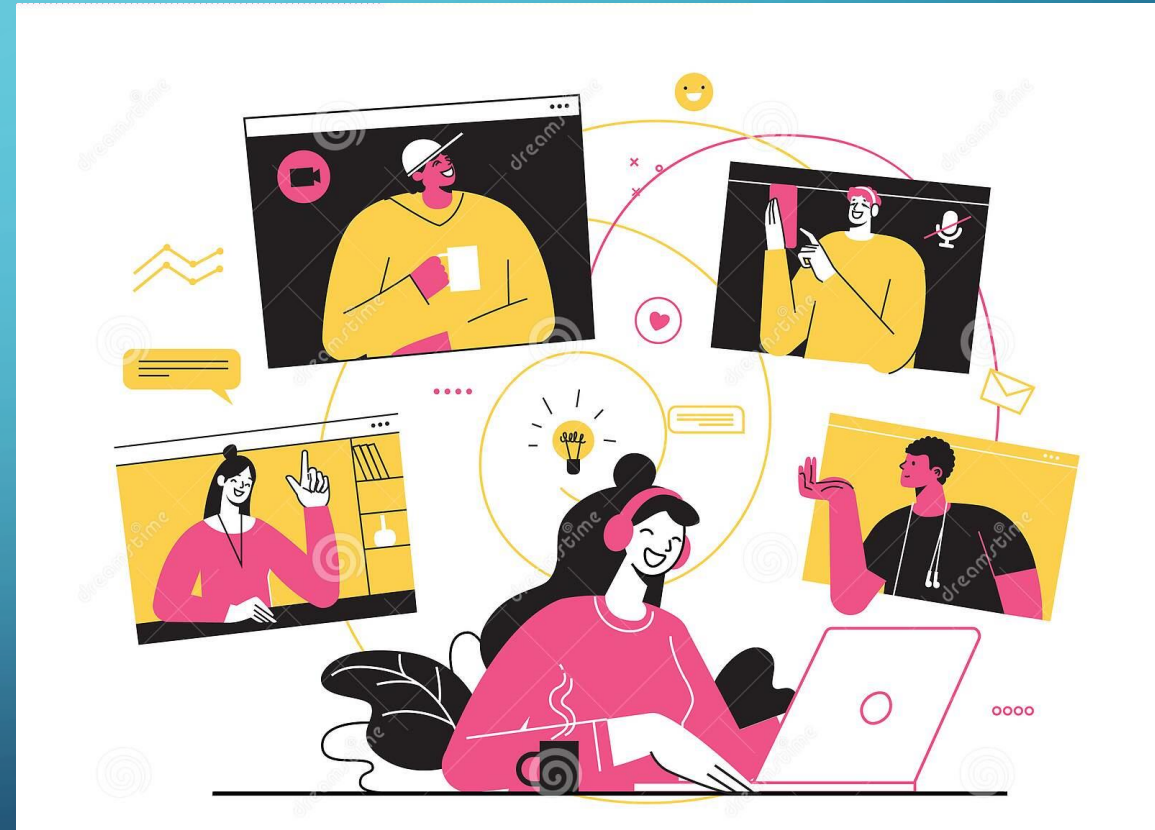

# INTERNET AS CREATIVE SPACE

- The Internet is a creative space that allows anyone to publish content for free
- That content is considered intellectual property of the creator



# INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- Intellectual property is protected by the law
- It is divided into 4 groups:
  - Copyright
  - Patents
  - Trademarks
  - Trade Secrets



# INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- Copyright laws are automatically added to your work
- Using someone's work without their permission is an illegal act of copyright



# PUBLISHING WORK

- As a creator you can publish your work in two ways:
  - Public domain
  - With license



# PUBLIC DOMAIN

- If we publish our work in public domain, it means that everyone can use our work and do what ever they want to it
- It belongs to the public, not us anymore



# LICENSE

- If we decide to publish our work with a license, it can be under a:
  - Copyright license
  - Creative commons license



# COPYRIGHT



- Copyright means that we own that work and it belongs only to use
- Others can use it only if we give them permission
- If someone uses our work without our permission, they are breaking the law and we can take legal actions against them



# CREATIVE COMMONS

- Creative Commons is a type of license where everyone can use our work for free but they have to follow certain rules that we have set up for our work



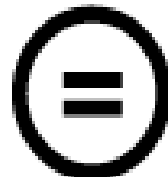

## Attribution

Others can copy, distribute, display, perform and remix your work if they credit your name as requested by you



ND

## No Derivative Works

Others can only copy, distribute, display or perform verbatim copies of your work



SA

## Share Alike

Others can distribute your work only under a license identical to the one you have chosen for your work



NC

## Non-Commercial

Others can copy, distribute, display, perform or remix your work but for non-commercial purposes only.
